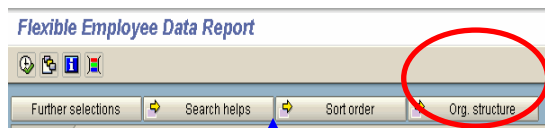



**Org structure, when available as a selection field, doesn't always output consistently from one report to another. Can you explain this functionality?**



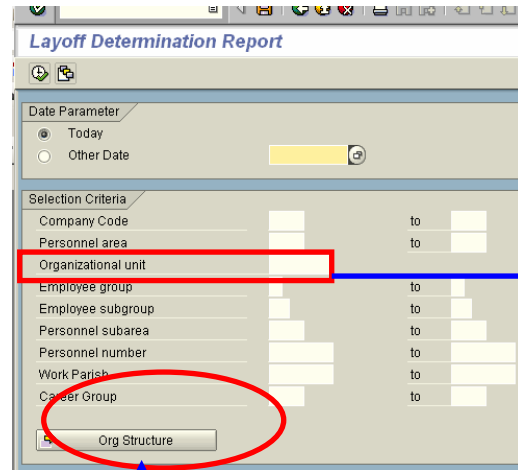
When you see these 4 buttons across the top of the report selection screen . . .

the Org. Structure button when utilized will pull in data for the Org Unit selected AND all subordinate units, irregardless of whether you selected the subordinate orgs or not.

If you instead click , select *Organizational Unit* and then enter individual org unit numbers or ranges of numbers, only those specified will be returned.

Examples of reports that work this way include ZP135, ZP82, ZP95 and ZHRBEN0072.

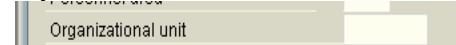

When using the Org. Structure button located within the Selection Criteria . . .

you can select either individual or ranges of org unit numbers and return only those numbers.

If you instead use



The output will include the organization unit entered, plus any units subordinate to that unit.

Examples of ISIS HR Reports that work this way include ZP19, ZP12, ZF22 and ZF09.
