


When Should I Delimit a Master Cost Center Assignment on a Position?

Issued 10/12/07

Run ZP84 using the /107_DIST variant. Look for any position (object S) that has 2 or more Cost Center (object K) output lines. Remember, the line without a % value is your Master Cost Center value.

If the position cost center assignment is the same as the cost center assignment on the superior org unit, the position cost center assignment record should be delimited. Always delimit effective the last day of the current pay period. **NEVER** delete the record.
