

NOTICE OF INTENT

Department of Health and Hospitals Office of Public Health

Children's Special Health Services (CSHS)
(LAC 48:V.Chapters 49-53)

In accordance with R.S. 49:950 et seq., the Administrative Procedure Act, the Department of Health and Hospital, Office of Public Health proposes to amend, repeal and reenact Part V of the Louisiana Administrative Code, Preventive Health Services, Subpart 17. Children's Special Health Services (CSHS) to resolve service delivery issues, as follows: Sections 4901, 4903, 4905, 5101, 5103, 5105, 5107, 5109, 5113, 5115, 5117, 5301, 5501, 5503, 5505, 5509, 5511, 5513, 5515, 5517, and 5519, to be repealed and reenacted; Section 5903, to be amended; Sections 5111, 5303, and 5305, to be repealed.
