### Codification and Amendment of Rules (LAC 58:I.Chapters 1-29)

The Department of the Treasury, Board of Trustees of the State Employees' Retirement System ("LASERS") advertises its intent to amend its rules revising LAC 58:I.Chapters 1-29. These rule amendments will codify existing rules into the Louisiana Administrative Code and make other updates.

### **FISCAL AND ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT FOR ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RULE TITLE: Codification and Amendment of Rules**
