Dear Senator Henry and Representative DeVillier:

Pursuant to La. R.S. 49:966(D)(1)(b), the Louisiana State Racing Commission hereby announces its plan to proceed with rule-making regarding the October 20, 2023 Notice of Intent of LAC 35:XI.9905 "Timing of Entering Next Claiming Race" that was promulgated on pages 1784 through 1785 of the *Louisiana Register*. The LSRC tentatively plans to vote for formal adoption of the rule at the next Public Commission Meeting and, following Commission approval, will submit to the Louisiana Register to be published after the required 90 days following Notice of Intent pursuant to La. R.S. 49:961 will have passed.

The proposed amendment of LAC 35:XI.9905 adds exceptions to the provisions of claiming procedures and clarifies language regarding when a claimed horse shall not run.

In regard to the proposed rule, this Commission has received no comments after the Notice of Intent was published and therefore has not conducted a hearing pursuant to La. R.S. 49:961(B).

The Commission has made no changes to the proposed rule.

Subject to legislative oversight by either the House Commerce Committee or Senate Commerce Committee, the Louisiana State Racing Commission intends to submit this chapter of Rules to the Office of the State Register for publication following the required time periods set forth in La.
