On-the-Go Flight Information - Given the recent rash of weather-related problems, if you're traveling and/or getting ready to catch a flight and you have concerns whether your flight is scheduled to be on time – either taking off or landing at your destination –you can always call the airline or airport where your flight is leaving. If, for whatever reason, you're unable to do that, for information that *may* be more up-to-date than even the airlines' systems, you can log on to one of the following free websites:

www.flightaware.com; www.flightexplorer.com; www.flightstats.com. Each of these sites accesses government radar and flight plan data and can track individual flights from takeoff to landing. The latter site even shows specific flights' historical on-time performance and will show the most reliable flight between two airports. Note that these sites offer flight information only, and to actually reschedule your travel you should either call us or, if your company has arranged for one of our online booking tools, access it via your laptop or desktop computer.
