## LOUISIANA INITIATIVE FOR VETERAN AND SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED SMALL ENTREPRENEURSHIPS (THE VETERAN INITIATIVE)

#### 2022 - 2023 FISCAL YEAR STATUS

For the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, the total reported state expenditures on contracts with certified Veteran Initiative entrepreneurships was \$25,806,532.32. At the end of the June 30, 2023 fiscal year period, LED reported six hundred and twenty (620) certified Veteran Initiative small entrepreneurships (382 Veteran-Owned and 238 Service-Connected Disabled). Of this number, a total of five hundred and twenty-eight (528) were registered in LaGov.

For the previous fiscal year (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022), the total reported expenditure on contracts was \$16,787,821.46. The table below is an overview of expenditures to Veteran Initiative small entrepreneurships for fiscal years July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 and July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. The DOA and state agencies in concert with LED are continuing our efforts to inform businesses about the program and to encourage their certification. The DOA is also encouraging state agencies to maximize their efforts in contracting with Veteran Initiative entrepreneurships.

# ADDITIONAL INITIATIVE REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY STATUTE

- A. La. R.S. 39:2177(C) requires the Commissioner of Administration to provide periodic training for relevant state employees to acquaint them with the requirements of the initiative and administrative law related thereto.
- B. La. R.S. 39:2177(D) requires the Commissioner of Administration to conduct a training program at least semiannually to acquaint small entrepreneurships with state procurement and public contract proposal and bidding practices.

On behalf of the Commissioner, the Office of State Procurement conducts outreach activities to acquaint Veteran Initiative entrepreneurships with state contracting and procurement, to encourage certification and to encourage Veteran Initiative entrepreneurships to enroll in the state's electronic vendor notification system, LaGov.
