Pursuant to R.S. 49:966(D)(1)(b), the Office of State Uniform Payroll hereby announces its plan to proceed with rule-making by finalizing the November 20, 2024, Notice of Intent that was promulgated on pages 1737 – 1739 of the *Louisiana Register*.

This rule-making was intended to allow approved across the board policy/rate changes to statewide/supplemental insurance vendor products to become effective to the policyholder/employee unless they express, in writing that they would like to terminate their policy/payroll deduction. This will bring the implementation of these changes more in line with how the Office of Group Benefits handles rate/policy changes.

The Office of State Uniform Payroll has received no comments and therefore has not conducted a hearing pursuant to R.S. 49:961(A)(2)(e).

No changes to the proposed rule have been made.
