#### **Narratives**

#### **Disaster Damage:**

Hurricane Gustav caused major wind and flood damage throughout the state, from the southern coastal parishes through central and north Louisiana. Two weeks later Hurricane Ike hit sending tidal surges across the States southern coastal communities. Ike exceeded storm surge caused by hurricanes Rita and Katrina. More than 1.9 million Louisiana residents were forced to evacuate for hurricanes Gustav and Ike. Many of these residents were unable to return to their homes and jobs for a number of days and a large number of residents whose homes remain unlivable continue to need short-term shelter and longer-term transitional housing. The State was forced to evacuate 30,000 critical transportation-need residents, including 10,400 medical evacuations, which is the largest medical evacuation in U.S. history. The State was also left with 1.5 million cubic yards of debris from Hurricane Gustav along federal and state highways. Approximately 150,000 to 300,000 homes experienced some level of damage in the storm; more than 12,000 homes were flooded. Preliminary estimates show that approximately \$2 to 7 billion in residential property loss was incurred. Even homes built to the Federal Emergency Management Agencies Advisory Base Flood Elevations flooded as a result of this storm. The state also estimates more than \$1 billion in public infrastructure damage. The state has spent more than \$400 million in emergency response and immediate recovery activities. Fifty-three of the States 64 parishes were included in the Presidents disaster declaration for individual assistance; all 64 were declared for public assistance. The two storms caused tremendous damage, which, in turn, left most communities without electricity for days, and many for weeks. More than 120,000 homes received some damage.

#### **Recovery Needs:**

A large percentage of the States educational facilities received damage from the storm. Preliminary estimates indicate that there was at least \$100 to \$150 million in damages to the primary (including pre-K) and secondary education facilities. While most of these repairs will be covered through FEMAs public assistance program, certain repairs or necessary rebuilds may be deemed ineligible through FEMAs program. Hurricanes Gustav and Ike impacted many of the States port facilities resulting in large economic losses to the State and exposing the nation to large and significant economic impacts if long term disruptions were to occur from hurricane impacts as much of the Nations oil and gas, commodity and cargo traffic flows through south Louisiana facilities. While oil and gas enter the Nation through facilities in south Louisiana, many more commodities that are vital to the upper Midwest, and north and central Louisiana flow down the Mississippi River and are maintained at specific temperatures at port warehouse facilities along the Mississippi River before becoming exports. These raw products in turn employ thousands of Louisianans and create millions of dollars in economic value.

While the majority of public infrastructure repairs will be covered by FEMA programs, it is known from experience with the 2005 storms that there are certain costs of repair including improvements or rebuilding will be deemed ineligible for FEMA funding.

Preliminary cost estimates for the repair of Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) eligible roads and bridges sustained as a result of Hurricane Gustav total \$127 million. Federal-aid highway damage estimates are about \$119 million. While funding to address these damages is authorized under current law, the backlog associated with these needs may prevent the restoration or threaten the integrity of this critical law, the backlog associated with these needs may prevent the restoration or threaten the integrity of this critical infrastructure. To repair this critical infrastructure, \$119 million would be needed for Louisiana (Gustav - \$53 million; Ike - \$66 million) through the Federal Highway Administrations Emergency Relief program.

Preliminary estimates indicate approximately \$1.7 billion in uninsured housing losses, with over half of that amount likely being homeowners. Hurricanes Katrina and Rita have taught us that repair costs generally outstrip insurance proceeds. Initial damage models based on flood and wind damage vary widely, but have a midpoint between \$3 and 4 billion dollars. Half of this damage may be uninsured losses due to uninsured and underinsured properties.

With losses of housing stock concentrated in certain communities, Louisiana could have up to \$1.5 billion in uncompensated housing losses.

Based of the 2007 Summary of Agriculture and Natural Resources by the LSU Agriculture Center and NMFS Revenue Data, the seafood industries experienced nearly \$250 million in revenue loss as a result of the two storms. Even prior to hurricanes Gustav and Ike, Louisianas fisheries were struggling to recover from more than \$528 million in losses resulting from hurricanes Katrina and Rita in 2005. Hurricanes Gustav and Ike moved across the central Gulf of Mexico through some of the Nations most valuable and productive fishing grounds at the start of the States most valuable shrimp season.

# **Overall Progress Narrative:**

State Programs

Throughout the quarter, staff of the Office of Community Development/Disaster Recovery Unit (OCD/DRU) made considerable progress in moving forward the state-implemented programs and worked to continue providing support to the parishes in the programs to be implemented on the local level. The state staff has received high remarks from HUD for the agriculture program, the invoicing process, the creation of an internet-based parish reporting and tracking system and the outreach approach in providing technical assistance and establishing performance

#### standards.

The application review and award decision process was completed for a number of state administered programs. The \$50 million Gustav/ Ike Affordable Rental Housing Program announced the funding of 16 projects which will create 852 rental units, 666 of which will be affordable units and 87 of which will be PSH. The \$10 million Comprehensive Resiliency Pilot Program made 29 resiliency planning awards totaling nearly \$9 million and 10 awards for over \$1 million for code enforcement. An additional four awards were made to create 147 rental units, including 123 affordable and 25 permanent supportive housing, through the Gustav/Ike Piggyback Rental Housing Program. The application period was opened for the Economic Revitalization Program, which is designed to promote job growth and creation across the hurricane-impacted areas. Several applications have been received and are under review.

Additionally, the state closed the application period for both the Municipalities Infrastructure Program (MIP) and the Innovation Loan and Technical Assistance Program (ILTAP). The \$30 million Municipalities Infrastructure Program received 146 applications totaling over \$116 million. The Innovation Loan and Technical Assistance Program, which will provide over \$20M in loans and technical assistance to small businesses by combining G/I funding with available Katrina/Rita economic development funds, received 41 applications totaling over \$50 million.

The OCD/DRU closely worked with the LA Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to assess the needs of the fishing community given the added stress imposed by the massive oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico. In response, the planning staff adjusted the Fisheries Programs to shift as 100% grant programs and extended the deadline to ensure participation by all commercial fishermen as well as the wholesale/dealer/brokers interested in the program. The application period ended during this quarter and applications are currently being evaluated for program eligibility. Awards are expected to be finalized next quarter.

Also, the Agribusiness loan and grant program completed all closings for the second round of funding of \$2.5 million. Award recipients for the Agriculture Farm Recovery Loan and Grant Program will receive a pro-rata share of an additional \$5 million allocated to the program. The La. Dept of Agriculture and Forestry is gathering necessary documentation to determine award amounts. All funds will be distributed by the end of this year.

#### Training, Planning and Technical Assistance

A Kick-Off Meeting was held July 23, 2010 for the Comprehensive Resiliency Pilot Program with all twenty-nine grant recipients in attendance. The agenda focused on resiliency and included experts in the fields of water management, mitigation/resiliency, GIS, citizen participation models from National APA Hazards Planning Research Center, Louisiana State University, University of Lafayette, University of New Orleans, National Trust for Public Land as well as OCD-DRU staff on the CDBG Disaster Recovery Administrative Manual. The Kick-off Meeting was followed-up by individual briefings with each grantee to go over requirements for revised task lists, budgets and RFP&rsquos reflecting requisite language for resiliency and mitigation.

On September 23, 2010, a Kick-Off meeting was held for Category 2 recipients under the Comprehensive Resiliency Grant Program whose focus will be building code regulations and addressing blight. The agenda included a presentation and discussion from the State Building Code Council.

Additionally, the state continued its outreach to local municipalities, towns and villages for the Municipal Infrastructure Program and held three (3) regional outreach events across the state, one statewide webinar and provided technical assistance at the Annual State Conference of the Louisiana Municipal Association in New Orleans (August 6-8, 2010) as a means of announcing the program as open for applications through August.

#### Parish Assistance

The planning and grant administration funds were also used to support the 53 disaster-impacted parishes which are designated to receive and directly administer more than 50% of the overall Gustav/Ike allocated funds. The state outreach staff continued to attend parish meetings as well as provided technical assistance on various topics including procurement and project monitoring. The Parish outreach team continued to receive and review parish proposals and guide parishes to using their CDBD Funds in clear ways which aim to create stronger parishes as they rebuild.

The program administration and planning expenditures also involved communications, website design, and management of the parish data reporting and tracking system. The Administrative expenditures included staff costs for general administration, financial services, human resource functions, assistance to constituents, and general

operations and travel costs.

The Parish-Implemented programs also gained momentum this quarter, with a continuation of administration expenditures in numerous parishes, as well as project expenditures for planning and the purchase of the Lamar-Dixon civic center. The state has developed the core of a program monitoring plan and is working with consultants to complete the schedule and review details.

The staff also continued to work closely with parishes to approve programs in the areas of infrastructure, housing, affordable rental and economic development. In addition, OCD/DRU continued to work with local parish governments to submit their Parish Recovery Plans and undertake the required public participation. An &IdquoAmendment Process for Gustav/Ike Proposals&rdquo was developed in July 2010 and distributed to parishes to facilitate and track necessary changes affecting projects &ndash i.e. cost projections to actual costs shifts in priority vs. alternate projects or the addition/deletion of projects, and projects that were ultimately funded from other sources. Since all projects are in the online system by parish, with a specific allocation for each project within the parish grant award, this facilitates the tracking of changes as well as the coordination between the various OCD-DRU departments approving project applications since it requires an amendment to the proposal first, if necessary, in order to approve an application for the actual cost reflected to complete the project. At least four parishes submitted a Tier III amendment requiring a public hearing for citizen input and numerous other Tier I and II amendments has been received and approved by the state.

The parish outreach staff made site visits to thirty-six(36) impacted Gustav/Ike parishes, meeting with both parish personnel and consultants, providing direct technical assistance to the top five most damaged parishes &ndash Terrebonne, Cameron, Iberville, East Baton Rouge and Lafourche &ndash in addition also to Jefferson, Assumption, Ascension, Calcasieu, Rapides, St. Landry, St. James, Tangipahoa, St. John, St. Charles, Franklin, Lafayette, St. Tammany, St. Helena, Catahoula, East Carroll, Beauregard, Richland, Concordia, Grant, Morehouse, St. Bernard, Washington, West Carroll, LaSalle, Vernon, Winn, Sabine, Madison, Tensas and Union. The Outreach Team is particularly tracking the submittal of pre-applications on a regular and consistent basis by parishes with a goal of all pre-applications for the 600+ parish projects being submitted to the state for review/approval by December 31, 2010. In addition, the Outreach Team is providing technical assistance in researching the impact of the storms and in accurately and specifically filling out the requisite information requested relative to the type of project and mitigation proposed.

## **Activity Progress Narrative:**

A Kick-Off Meeting was held July 23, 2010 for the Comprehensive Resiliency Pilot Program with all twenty-nine grant recipients in attendance. The agenda focused on resiliency and included experts in the fields of water management, mitigation/resiliency, GIS, citizen participation models from National APA Hazards Planning Research Center, Louisiana State University, University of Lafayette, University of New Orleans, National Trust for Public Land as well as OCD-DRU staff on the CDBG Disaster Recovery Administrative Manual. The Kick-off Meeting was followed-up by individual briefings with each grantee to go over requirements for revised task lists, budgets and RFP&rsquos reflecting requisite language for resiliency and mitigation.

On September 23, 2010, a Kick-Off meeting was held for Category 2 recipients under the Comprehensive Resiliency Grant Program whose focus will be building code regulations and addressing blight. The agenda included a presentation and discussion from the State Building Code Council.

Additionally, the state continued its outreach to local municipalities, towns and villages for the Municipal Infrastructure Program and held three (3) regional outreach events across the state, one statewide webinar and provided technical assistance at the Annual State Conference of the Louisiana Municipal Association in New Orleans (August 6-8, 2010) as a means of announcing the program as open for applications through August.

## **Activity Progress Narrative:**

The planning and grant administration funds were also used to support the 53 disaster-impacted parishes which are designated to receive and directly administer more than 50% of the overall Gustav/Ike allocated funds. The state outreach staff continued to attend parish meetings as well as provided technical assistance on various topics including procurement and project monitoring. The Parish outreach team continued to receive and review parish proposals and guide parishes to using their CDBD Funds in clear ways which aim to create stronger parishes as they rebuild.

The program administration and planning expenditures also involved communications, website design, and management of the parish data reporting and tracking system. The Administrative expenditures included staff costs for general administration, financial services, human resource functions, assistance to constituents, and general operations and travel costs.

The Parish-Implemented programs also gained momentum this quarter, with a continuation of administration expenditures in numerous parishes, as well as project expenditures for planning and the purchase of the Lamar-Dixon civic center. The state has developed the core of a program monitoring plan and is working with consultants to complete the schedule and review details.

The staff also continued to work closely with parishes to approve programs in the areas of infrastructure, housing, affordable rental and economic development. In addition, OCD/DRU continued to work with local parish governments to submit their Parish Recovery Plans and undertake the required public participation. An &ldquoAmendment Process for Gustav/lke

Proposals&rdquo was developed in July 2010 and distributed to parishes to facilitate and track necessary changes affecting projects &ndash i.e. cost projections to actual costs shifts in priority vs. alternate projects or the addition/deletion of projects, and projects that were ultimately funded from other sources. Since all projects are in the online system by parish, with a specific allocation for each project within the parish grant award, this facilitates the tracking of changes as well as the coordination between the various OCD-DRU departments approving project applications since it requires an amendment to the proposal first, if necessary, in order to approve an application for the actual cost reflected to complete the project. At least four parishes submitted a Tier III amendment requiring a public hearing for citizen input and numerous other Tier I and II amendments has been received and approved by the state.

The parish outreach staff made site visits to thirty-six(36) impacted Gustav/Ike parishes, meeting with both parish personnel and consultants, providing direct technical assistance to the top five most damaged parishes &ndash Terrebonne, Cameron, Iberville, East Baton Rouge and Lafourche &ndash in addition also to Jefferson, Assumption, Ascension, Calcasieu, Rapides, St. Landry, St. James, Tangipahoa, St. John, St. Charles, Franklin, Lafayette, St. Tammany, St. Helena, Catahoula, East Carroll, Beauregard, Richland, Concordia, Grant, Morehouse, St. Bernard, Washington, West Carroll, LaSalle, Vernon, Winn, Sabine, Madison, Tensas and Union. The Outreach Team is particularly tracking the submittal of pre-applications on a regular and consistent basis by parishes with a goal of all pre-applications for the 600+ parish projects being submitted to the state for review/approval by December 31, 2010. In addition, the Outreach Team is providing technical assistance in researching the impact of the storms and in accurately and specifically filling out the requisite information requested relative to the type of project and mitigation proposed.
